From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,



As we enter the final days of Advent, the Gospel places before us one of the quiet giants of our faith: St. Joseph. There are no recorded words in Scripture from St. Joseph, he is not quoted, which does not make him in any way insignificant – his life proclaims a powerful message of dignity, courage, and hope. When his world is suddenly turned upside down by

news he can't understand, St. Joseph doesn't react out of fear or anger. Instead, Matthew tells us he is a righteous man – a good man – who pauses, reflects, and responds with compassion and trust.

St. Joseph teaches us something essential for Advent and for life: that the virtue of hope is often lived very quietly. It's found not in having all the answers, but in trusting God enough to take the next faithful step. When the angel tells Joseph, "Do not be afraid," Joseph believes that God has a plan – even when he cannot yet see it.

His "yes" has a price for him, and St. Joseph accepts a future he didn't choose, protects Mary and Jesus from danger, and willingly steps into the background so that God's plan may unfold. In doing so, he shows us that true greatness is found not in being seen, but in being faithful. As Christmas draws near, St. Joseph invites us to slow down, to listen, and to trust. When we choose faith over fear, God is already at work – quietly guiding every moment. May St. Joseph's steady hope strengthen our homes, our parish, and our hearts as we prepare to welcome Christ at Christmas!
