THANK YOU for your generosity, continuing to help us reach our goal! We have completed several projects already and have several major projects ahead of us, HVAC system replacement, roof replacement in the Parish Hall and roof repairs as well some interior reconstruction in the Rectory – we are also looking to renovate the Parish Hall to maximize space we have and make upgrades. **Our goal to reach by December 2023 is \$500,000. We are currently at \$236,760.51.**
