- Celebrating Milestones Together: From feast days to parish anniversaries, this ministry helps us celebrate as a family of faith.
- ♣ Evangelization Through Hospitality: Inviting friends and neighbors to parish meals and socials is a low-barrier way to share the joy of our faith.
