Carly-Bird/Commuter Masses

To accommodate many who commute to work, as well as our "early birds" we will be offering early morning Masses three days each week. Mass will be offered Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 6:30am. (Please note, the church will be opened at 6:00am for personal and private prayer.

We will continue to offer Mass later in the morning, moving our 8:15am Masses to 9:00am.

We will also celebrate Mass on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday at 9:00am. The church will remain open for private prayer between the 6:30am and 9:00am Masses and will open at 8:00am on Saturday. The church will remain open for one hour following the Wednesday 6:30am Mass.

Please note: We encourage all who attend the Mass at 9:00am <u>during weekdays</u> to be aware that many parents utilize our church parking lot to drop off their children at St. Bernadette CES. Since we enjoy a mutual partnership with the school, this permission will continue and may affect latecomers who arrive close to Mass time.

Friday Changes

We will continue to have adoration following the 9:00am Mass and until Noon on First Fridays and adoration until 10:00am every other Friday. We will also have confessions available following the Friday 9:00am Mass. We will no longer have the evening confessions and Mass on First Fridays, as both have been poorly attended since we brought it back.

Weekday Mass at Archbishop Denis G'Connor

Starting in October, we will be celebrating a weekday Mass on the 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Wednesdays of each month at 8:45am in the DOC Chapel. This Mass is for staff and students, but we encourage people at DOC to attend.
