# From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,



In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 18:1-8), Jesus tells the parable of the persistent widow who never gives up in seeking justice. Her perseverance moves even an unjust judge, and Jesus reminds us that our Heavenly Father, who loves us deeply, will surely hear the cries of His people. At the heart of this teaching is not only

persistence in prayer but also trust in God's unfailing love.

God's love is constant, and unlike the judge, He does not need to be persuaded or worn down. Instead, He delights in listening to His children. When we turn to Him with our needs, with the joys and struggles of life, He receives us with mercy and compassion. Prayer is not about convincing God to care, but about opening ourselves to His care that is already present.

As a parish community, we are called to reflect this same love. Just as God listens to us, we are invited to listen to one another, to support each other in times of need, and to encourage each other in faith. A community rooted in God's love becomes a living witness to the Gospel-where persistence in prayer meets persistence in love.

This week, let us be mindful of the ways we can both bring our petitions before God with faith, and also respond to those around us with generosity of heart. In doing so, we become instruments of the very love that Jesus speaks of in today's Gospel.
