This weekend, we celebrate the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed—All Souls' Day—a profound reminder of the Church's belief in the Communion of Saints: that the living and the dead remain united in Christ's love. We do not forget those who have gone before us; we accompany them with our prayers, just as we trust that one day others will pray for us. In

praying for the souls in purgatory, we express both love and hope-love that continues beyond death, and hope in God's mercy that purifies and perfects all who long to see Him face to face. This feast calls us to remember that prayer truly binds us together as one family of faith, spanning heaven, earth, and those being purified for heaven. Let us pray for our departed loved ones, for the forgotten souls, and for one another—so that, strengthened by grace, we may all share eternal life in Christ.

I appreciate your understanding that pastoral duties often take me beyond the office, and I'm grateful for your patience and prayers as we serve one another in Christ.
