IMPORTANCE of RCIA & SCRUTINIES

The Second Vatican Council took place from 1962-1965 under the leadership of Pope St. John XXIII and Pope St. Paul VI, brought the bishops, theologians, and Catholic leaders together – its goal to refresh, renew and return the Catholic Church to her Mission given by Jesus Christ. One of the most significant “developments” was the way adults especially were welcomed, received, renewed, returned, and prepared as the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) was established. When we celebrate the many various rites and rituals, they should not be seen as an inconvenience, but a CALL for all of us to pray for and discern with our newest members, but also a time to reflect on our own faith development – whether we are adult converts or “cradle Catholics”, we are one in faith which we hope develops through a lifetime.

Our ten members will experience the 3rd and final Scrutiny this weekend. The Elect prayerfully reflect on their lives through each of the Scrutinies, asking the Lord to purify them and bring them closer to that day they will enter the waters of baptism, of joining us in full communion at Easter. Easter will be for them as Christians, the MOST significant event of their Christian lives and the Scrutinies help ready them for it – let us reflect that we are ready to grow in our faith too.

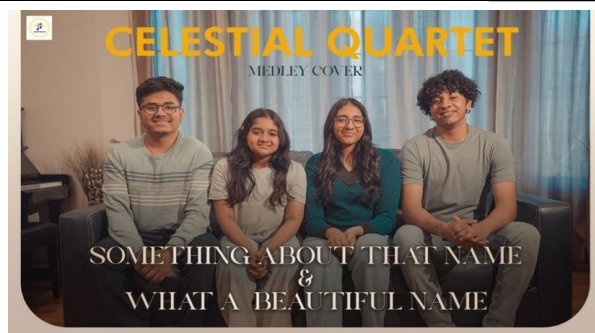
