## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,



In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 17:5-10), the disciples beg the Lord: "Increase our faith!" Jesus reminds them that even faith the size of a mustard seed can do the impossible. This is a powerful reminder that faith is not something we manufacture on our own—it is a gift from God.

When we pause to reflect, two of the greatest gifts we have received are the **gift of life** and the **gift of faith**. Life itself is pure gift: none of us chose to be born, and every breath we take is sustained by God's loving hand. To cherish life means to recognize its sacredness—our own lives, and the lives of those around us, especially the vulnerable, the sick, and the forgotten.

The second gift, faith, opens our eyes to see life not as random or meaningless, but as purposeful and filled with hope. Faith helps us face trials with courage, endure suffering with trust, and rejoice in blessings with gratitude. Even the smallest seed of faith can grow and transform our lives, if we allow God to water it.

This week, I invite you to take time to celebrate both these gifts-life and faith. Cherish them, nurture them, and share them. For when we live with gratitude for these two greatest treasures, we truly become witnesses of God's love in the world.
