From the Pastor's Desk



My dear Friends in Christ,

We've got some trees on the church property that are splitting, the branches are breaking slightly, and you'll notice as the leaves blossom,

some of these branches WILL have leaves, but they will be small and for some of them, the buds will struggle to produce any leaves at all. Parts of the trees are healthy, parts of them are dying. Without being fully attached to the tree and only partially attached, they are not "fully alive" as they ought to be, but lesser branches; branches that will eventually die.

We have been blessed at St. Bernadette's with the presence of newly ordained priests, seminarians and many of our young people beginning to earnestly discern where God is calling them to in life. On May 11, we will celebrate (at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica) the Ordination to the Holy Priesthood, five men (including our next Associate Pastor, Father Daniel Lee). Two weeks later, on Saturday May 25 we will celebrate our own parishioner Mr. Ron Vaz ordained to the Permanent Diaconate, and Ron has been assigned as Deacon here at St. Bernadette's.


