Father Chris' Advent Message

As we approach the beginning of Advent, we 'change gears' liturgical as well. Here are a few changes you will notice in the liturgical and sacramental celebrations as of the First Sunday of Advent (we begin Year A in the readings again):

- No Gloria will be sung at Mass
- An Advent Penitential Rite will be used at Mass
- Our Memorial Acclamation will be "Save us Saviour of the World, for by Your Cross and Resurrection, You have set us free"
- There will be no Adoration on Wednesdays and Fridays during Advent. Instead, Fr. Chris will provide a short Advent Reflection Series on Wednesdays: December 3rd, 10th, and 17th, from 7:00pm to 7:20pm.
- We welcome families from the parish for the Advent Family Mass, with pre-Mass carolling and concert starting at 6pm, Mass at 7pm and a social gathering at 8pm
- We will gather for our Advent Day of Recollection -Saturday December 13th starting with the 9am Mass and concluding at 2pm
- Our Altar and Sanctuary will be adorned simply
- ➤ We will gather as a community for the Pre-Dawn Novena Masses at 5:30am each morning, starting Tuesday December 16th with the last Mass on Christmas Eve

We hope to see as many of you through the Advent season. May the Lord continue to bless you all.
