## **Habemus Papam – Pope Leo XIV Elected!**

The Church rejoices in the election of **Pope Leo XIV**, the 267th successor of St. Peter. Cardinal **Robert Francis Prevost, O.S.A.**, originally from Chicago, becomes the first US-born pope in history. A former Augustinian provincial and missionary in Peru, his ministry has long reflected both pastoral zeal and global service.

Stepping onto the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, the new Holy Father humbly invoked the legacy of Pope Francis and offered words of hope and unity: "God loves everyone. Evil will not prevail. We are all in the hands of God... united, hand in hand with God and with each other, we go forward."

Pope Leo XIV expressed his desire to continue building bridges of peace through dialogue and called all people to be disciples of Christ and bearers of His light. Quoting St. Augustine, he reminded the faithful: "For you I am a bishop; but with you I am a Christian."

He concluded his first appearance by leading the Church in prayer with the *Ave Maria*, entrusting his pontificate to Our Lady and inviting all to journey with him in faith and love.
